A Place To Get Smart About Careers

(NAPS)—Looking for a new job now requires a bit less work thanks to a Web site that helps job seekers make smart career decisions. The service is called America's Career InfoNet (ACI) (www.acinet.org). It was developed and is maintained through the U.S. Department of Labor.



A Web site for smart career decisions is having a profound impact on the nation's job seekers.

ACINet provides valuable information resources for job seekers and employers alike. These include wage and employment trends, occupational requirements, state-by-state labor market profiles and contact information on millions of employers nationwide. Recent enhancements include a career resource library with 3,500 external links, 200 career videos viewable online, and on-demand information on available jobs through America's Job Bank.

The site also helps job seekers learn about education and training available to help them reach their goals.

ACINet is part of America's Career Kit. Other components of the Kit include America's Learning eXchange (www.alx.org), America's Service Locator (www.servicelocator.org), which helps workers and employers find the nearest employment and training service providers and America's Job Bank (www.ajb.org), which provides information about job vacancies.
