The plant, which has no serious pest problems, should be planted in sunlight, which brings out the rich, dark pigments. This variety can reach a height of three to five feet, making it a terrific choice for use as a hedge, or in a shrub or perennial border to provide season-long color. In addition, the funnel-shaped flowers are adored by hummingbirds.
