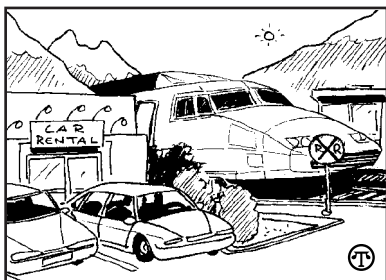


TIPS ON TRIPS

Best Of Both Worlds

(NAPSA)—Travelers to Europe can have the “best of both worlds” by combining trains and rental cars with a Rail ’n Drive pass from Rail Europe, the leading European travel supplier in North America.



For longer distances, the best bet is trains, especially high-speed TGV trains in France, ICEs in Germany, AVE trains in Spain and more. They move at more than 180 miles an hour, which minimizes your travel time. For out-of-the-way places, use the car days on the Rail ’n Drive pass. Car rental offices are generally at rail stations across western and central Europe. Simply get off the train and walk into the car rental office to pick up the vehicle.

In France you get 2 days of unlimited train travel plus two days of Avis economy car rental with unlimited miles in any month for \$205 when two travel together. Rail and car days don't have to be consecutive and you can get extra days of either if you buy them here when you book your Rail ’n Drive pass. These passes are not available in Europe.
