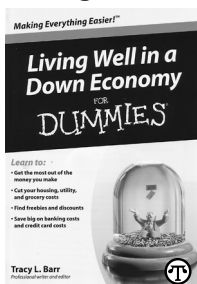

Books Worth Giving

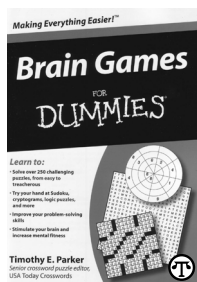

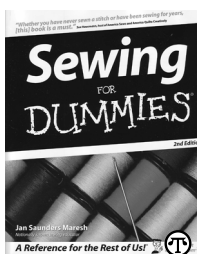
