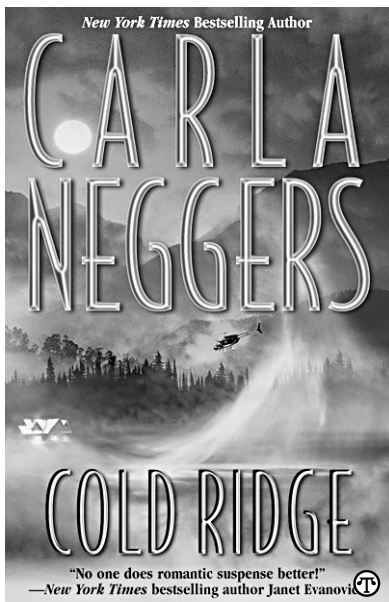


Books Worth Reading

Cold Ridge

(NAPSA)—*New York Times* bestselling author Carla Neggers spins a chilling tale of romantic suspense set against the unforgiving backdrop of New England's rugged White Mountains, in *Cold Ridge* (MIRA Books, \$6.99).



Carine Winters is an award-winning nature photographer known for her propensity to take any risk to get the best shot of her quarry. Tyler North is a veteran pararescuer who regularly risks his life in daring helicopter missions. Neighbors as children, the two meet again when Ty saves Carine from a mysterious sniper attack in the mountains near their hometown of Cold Ridge, New Hampshire.

Their youthful lack of interest turns into a very adult brand of passion—yet Ty leaves Carine at the altar, convincing himself he's doing the best thing for her. Confused, Carine relocates to Boston and takes a job documenting the restoration of an historic Back Bay home.
