In a new report, "Greater Expectations: A New Vision for Learning as a Nation Goes to College," the Association argues that higher education should provide all students a practical and engaged liberal education relevant for today's world and regardless of students' majors. The report recommends major reforms that include:

- Ensuring a coherent curriculum for today's students, including the growing number who attend multiple institutions and work while learning;
- Helping students become intentional, continuous learners capable of responding to challenges;
- Requiring students to apply learning to the real world;
- Creating alignments between colleges and high schools to better prepare students for college learning.
