

VA Enlists Public's Help In Contacting Former POWs

(NAPSA)—Do you know a former prisoner of war? If so, the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) needs your help in making sure that former POWs know about the benefits they earned.

VA estimates that more than 30,000 former prisoners of war are alive today. However, about 10,000 are not receiving any VA benefits.

The government's effort to inform former POWs about improvements in benefits faces a particular hurdle with older veterans, many from WWII, who may not have been in touch with VA for decades.

Recently, the federal government expanded benefits to all former POWs with strokes and certain common heart diseases. More than a dozen other diseases are already covered.
