Cool, Smooth And Delicious Creations

For example, this year, more and more spirits fans will enjoy drinks made with premium Mexican tequila.

It is said that the best tequila comes from 100 percent pure Blue Agave rested or aged in oak barrels. Agave, found exclusively in the Jalisco area of Mexico, is the family of plants used to produce mezcal and tequila.

The flavor and smoothness of each tequila is determined by the quality of its ingredients and the aging process it has undergone. There are many different tequila varieties to choose from including Tres Generaciones, Sauza Hornitos and Sauza Conmemorativo.

From traditional summer drinks such as “Sauza Pure Margarita” to new twists on trendy taste sensations such as “Sauza Cosmopolitan,” the following are a few simple recipes.

Sauza Pure Margarita

2 parts Tres Generaciones tequila
1 part Hiram Walker Triple Sec



2 parts freshly-squeezed lime juice

Shake with ice, pour into a margarita glass (salted rim optional). Garnish with lime wedges.

Sauza Cosmopolitan

1½ oz. Tres Generaciones
1 oz. Cointreau
1 oz. Lime juice
1 oz. Cranberry juice

Shake ingredients well and pour into a martini glass. Garnish with a lime twist.
