




BOOK REVIEW

Cypress Point

However, neither guilt, Liam nor her unborn child will stop Joelle from doing anything she can to save Mara—even if that means bringing in a controversial healer.

Drawing upon her own background in social work and psychology, Ms. Chamberlain centers her writing on relationships and human complexities. She is a master at creating emotionally charged plots with just enough twists and surprises to keep readers on their toes.
