5. If you do see smoke or fire, **Get Low and Go**, meeting at your designated family meeting place.

6. When cooking in the kitchen, don't wear loose clothing. Make sure children follow that rule and keep them away from open flames.

7. If a piece of clothing does catch on fire:

a. **Stop.** Don't run.

b. **Drop.** Lie on the ground; cover your eyes and face with your hands; and

c. **Roll!** Roll your body on the ground until the flames are out.
