

# Do You Have The “Will To Win”?

(NAPSA)—Applications for Schering-Plough’s “Will to Win” college scholarship are now being accepted for high school seniors with asthma who are pursuing higher education. “Will to Win” demonstrates to young asthma sufferers that the condition, when properly treated and managed, need not impede their ability to excel. This fall, a total of \$50,000 in scholarships will be awarded to 10 students.

All scholarship winners will be required to supply documentation of U.S. citizenship, acceptance to an accredited college and enrollment in college in the fall 2007 semester.
