## Driving Tips

(NAPSA)—You can drive down your risk of an accident on the road if you heed the advice of some safety-award-winning truckers:

- Be patient and stay focused.
- Look farther ahead—let your eyes lead your wheels.
- Avoid distractions, such as cell phones, PDAs or loud music.
- Never drive when tired.
- When passing a truck, don't slide back into the traffic flow until you can see both of its headlights in your rearview mirror.



**Drive safely: Keep the proper distance from other vehicles.**

- Remember that blind spots can prevent a truck driver from seeing you. The rule is “if you can't see the driver in his mirror, he cannot see you.”

These tips come from the 78 FedEx drivers who won state driving championships with their driving skills and knowledge of the rules of the road. Collectively, they have driven more than 92 million miles without an accident—enough to circle the globe almost 3,700 times.
