




GREAT NEW BOOKS

(NAPSA)—Given the flurry of interest in fairies, a new book by the elusive fairie couturier Ellwand is going to enchant a lot of readers. His book, *Fairie-ality: The Fashion Collection from the House of Ellwand* (Candlewick Press, \$40), allows mortals a peek at his ethereal designs in a catalogue so beautifully crafted it befits a fairie queen.



Welcome to *Fairie-ality*—In his book, a celebrated designer conjures fabrics from fantasy and dresses from dreams.

Showcased are nearly 150 creations—including jackets, trousers, shoes, hats, elegant gowns and fantasy dresses, and delicate unmentionables—fashioned wholly from feathers, flower petals, shells, seeds, and other materials from nature.

Ellwand, whose UK design shop is apparently “just a few miles from the rumored High Seat of the Fairies,” has been praised by the fashion press, including *Elle*, *InStyle* and *Marie Claire* magazines, both here and in England.
