

Experience History Ride A “Duck”

(NAPSA)—Visitors to Wisconsin Dells can take in the scenery and learn a little history when they ride like a world leader aboard an Original Wisconsin Duck. These unique land-and-water vehicles take visitors on an 8.5-mile tour of the Dells’ beauti-



ful terrain. Nearly 60 years ago, ducks were vital in tackling the rugged beaches of Europe and the South Pacific during World War II and proved an invaluable tool for the Allies. In the days following D-Day, three world leaders rode ashore at Normandy on ducks: British Prime Minister Winston Churchill, Britain’s King George VI and the soon-to-be French President Charles De Gaulle.

Today’s ducks take Dells visitors in and around the scenic Wisconsin River with its towering sandstone cliffs. The one-hour tour also splashes down into Lake Delton, navigates narrow, shady gorges and climbs winding trails, treating passengers to beautiful vistas.
