Fluoridated bottled water is clearly labeled, so consumers will know whether or not they are choosing bottled water with or without the mineral. About 30 companies that belong to the International Bottled Water Association (IBWA) produce fluoridated bottled water.

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) fully regulates all bottled water as a packaged food product, with stringent safety, labeling and other standards so consumers can rely upon safe, high quality and good tasting bottled water products.
