## “GoldenEye: Rogue Agent”

“**The Lord of the Rings: The Third Age**”—This role-playing game for the consoles lets players adventure through Middle-earth, building a party of heroes as they journey. Players battle on the side of the Fellowship but can unlock additional encounters where they fight on the side of Sauron as they progress. In the game, players will
