Health Care Workers

(NAPSA)—The Department of Labor predicts a 26 percent increase in the number of health care jobs by 2008. The increased demand is expected to continue for another 50 years.

Health care jobs expected to increase dramatically include home health aids (76 percent), home care aids (85 percent), medical assistants (71 percent) and physical therapy assistants (79 percent).
