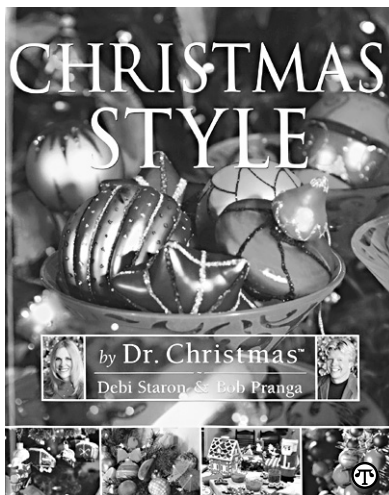


Holiday Glamour
