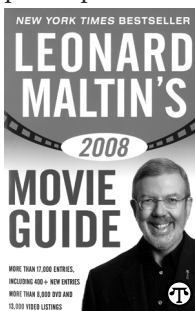


# Book Notes

## Movie Guide Helps Fans Get The Picture
