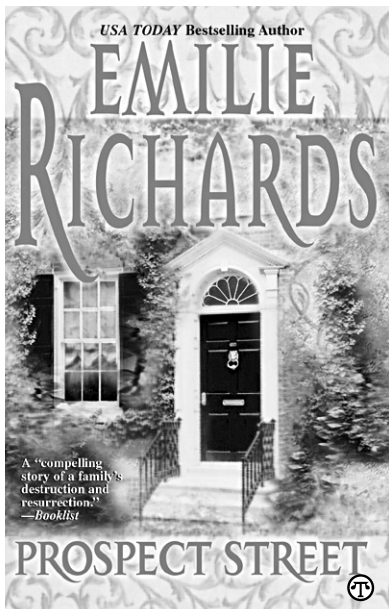




### Prospect Street
