Pumpkin Burgers

- 1½ pound ground beef**
- 1 medium onion, chopped**
- 12 oz. jar chili sauce**
- 1 can tomato soup**
- ½ cup pumpkin**
- 1 tsp. salt**
- 1 tsp. pepper**
- 1 tsp. pumpkin pie spice**

In a large pan, brown together ground beef and chopped onion. Stir in all other ingredients and bring to a simmer. Let the mixture cook for 1 hour, stirring occasionally. Serve on buns.

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
