The Christmas Basket (Mira Books, \$14.95) has been called a laugh-out-loud novel. It describes the straining tensions and flaring tempers between two long-feuding rivals required to spend time with each other over the holidays.

A Gift To Last (Mira Books, \$6.99) contains two heartwarming holiday stories. One tells of a group of strangers who are reminded what the holiday is all about when they are forced to spend Christmas Eve together. The second tale marks the return of Macomber's three popular angels as they show a bitter humbug what Christmas really means.
