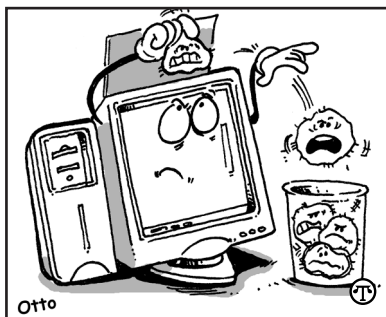
Detect And Remove Malicious Software From PCs
