Youth Fight To Save Orphans

(NAPSA)—America's youth are taking action to fight a global killer of millions—AIDS.

The One Life Revolution Campaign, launched by World Vision and Youth Specialties, is a long-term effort with a short-term goal—to raise \$1 million by June 2003.



Relief efforts are directed at the more than 1.2 million orphans in Zambia.

The money will be used to improve the lives of orphans and widows affected by AIDS in the southern African country of Zambia, where 21.5 percent of the population ages 15 to 49 is infected with HIV/AIDS. There are over 1.2 million orphans in Zambia with no means of income, food, health care or an education.

One Life Revolution challenges American youth to raise funds for specific interventions via the One Life Revolution catalog.
